

YAS (USA) opens a representative office in Monterrey

Yusen Air & Sea Service (U.S.A.) Inc. (president: Masatoshi Moriya) opened a representative office in Monterrey, northern Mexico, as the second logistics base for the country and started operations on October 25, 2004.

The purpose for opening the office is to be prepared for the Japan-Mexico FTA enforcement, following the representative office, which opened in Mexico City in September. This completes the deployment to a line consisting of major cities between central Mexico and the U.S.-Mexico border, including Mexico City, Monterrey, and Laredo (Texas, U.S.A.).

Although YAS (U.S.A.) already provides customers with trailer arrangements, cross-boarder formalities, cross-boarder trailer tracking management services for U.S.-Mexico logistics, and increases in the number of logistics bases further improves the quality of service for customers in Monterrey. Simultaneously, we will further enhance the liaison with the logistics operation in the Laredo Service Center, under the control of Houston branch, and promote the U.S.-Mexico cross-boarder logistics enhancement plan, which has been carried out by YAS (USA).
